



FIRE BAN

Effective: 0900hrs August 10, 2022

Pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Forests and Prairie Protection Act, and Cypress County Bylaw 2022/04, Cypress County hereby orders, effective as of the above stated time, the following:

1. A Fire Ban is being implemented regarding all fires **(including fireworks)** within the boundaries of Cypress County. All fire permits have been cancelled.
2. A person who wilfully sets an open fire, or any fire not allowed under this order, may be charged under the Forest and Prairie Protection Act and Cypress County Bylaw 2022/04. If the person is the owner or occupant of the land on which the fire is set, those costs may be recovered by placing the costs on the tax roll and recovering them in the same manner as taxes.

This order amends any previous fire control orders.

Cypress County is in Fire Ban with extreme fire hazard due to lack of precipitation, hot and dry conditions, and resource management.
