A Bylaw of Cypress County in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw 2022/09 being the Land Use Bylaw.


PURSUANT TO the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of Cypress County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Having received an application (22/A08) from Global Raymac Surveys Inc., on behalf of George and Judith Russill, to re-classify a portion of the SW 22-8-3-W4, as shown on the attached Schedule A, from Agricultural District 2 "A2" to Country Residential District 2 "CR-2".
- 2. Having held a public hearing on the matter, Land Use Bylaw 2022/09, is hereby amended to change that portion of the SW 22-8-3-W4, as shown on the attached Schedule A, from Agricultural District 2 "A2" to Country Residential District 2 "CR-2".
- 3. This bylaw shall take effect upon final registration of the subdivision plan.
- 4. If no subdivision plan is registered within 2 years of the final reading of the Bylaw, the Bylaw shall be null and void.
